Who Wants to Compete in Memphis?

DCBS will again host its annual competitions to determine which band and solo/duo act will represent DCBS and compete in next year's International Blues Challenge (IBC) in Memphis, TN. These DCBS competitions are set for September 2018, and the IBC is held Jan. 22-26, 2019.

In addition, DCBS may send a youth band or solo/duo act to perform at the IBC in the Youth category, although the IBC does not hold a competition in this category. DCBS also will accept entries for the IBC's Best Self-Produced CD category.

The DCBS deadline for entering all categories is July 31, 2018. More information will be posted to the DCBS website: www.dcblues.org. This article focuses on the band and solo/duo competitions because any performer who wants to compete in the DCBS events

should apply early and be sure to save the relevant date(s) below:

The DCBS Battle of the Bands and Solo/ Duo Competition comprise a CD review and an all-live competition.

Battle of the Bands: Saturday, Sept.15 Solo/Duo Competition: Friday, Sept. 28

at the American Legion–Cissel Saxon Post 41, 905 Sligo Ave., Silver Spring, MD 20910.

The winners of each event will be paid to perform at the 2018 Free College Park Blues Festival (an IBC Fundraiser) on Saturday, Nov. 10 **AND** at the 2019 Annual DC Blues Festival (subject to change) **AND** represent the DC Blues Society at the 2019 International Blues Challenge.



SIDEMEN: LONG ROAD TO GLORY is scheduled for release on Monday, June 4 exclusively on iTunes. Release of a DVD will follow in July.

SIDEMEN: LONG ROAD TO GLORY is an intimate look at the incredible lives and legacies of piano player Pinetop Perkins, drummer Willie 'Big Eyes' Smith and guitarist Hubert Sumlin, all Muddy Waters and Howlin' Wolf sidemen.

The film captures some of the last interviews and their final live performances together, before their deaths in 2011. The historic live shows are accompanied by performances and personal insights from many of the blues and rock stars these legendary sidemen inspired including; Bonnie Raitt, Gregg Allman, Derek Trucks, Shemekia Copeland, Robby Krieger, Kenny Wayne Shepherd, Joe Perry, Joe Bonamassa and Johnny Winter.

In April, the film was awarded the gold medal for Best Music Documentary by the NYF Film and Television Awards.



To Enter:

Print and complete the DCBS IBC Application, which will be available on the DCBS website.

Send **all** of the following:

- Completed form with confirmation of DCBS membership, and noting which competition you're entering: Battle of the Bands or Solo/Duo Competition. At least one Band or Solo/Duo member must be a DCBS member. If not a member, visit www.dcblues.org to join online or download the application.
- 2. Confirmation that you and your band have read the Scoring Criteria, Penalties, and Eligibility Criteria.
- 3. At least 3 sample tunes on CD
- Official band name
- 5. Short band bio (100 words or less)
- 6. A digital color or B&W photo with a 300 dpi resolution
- 7. A link to your website

Solo/Duo Competition, Youth Competition and Self-Produced CD entries should be emailed to <code>president@dcblues.org</code> and hard copies should also be mailed to the address below. Note: Both emailed and hard copy mailings are required and must be submitted by the July 31 deadline.

Eligibility Criteria:

- ▲ The winner is obligated to attend the International Blues Challenge competition in Memphis, TN, January 22-26, 2019.
- An act is limited to three consecutive appearances at the IBC and must then sit out at least one year before being eligible to compete again.
- Any artist whose name has appeared on a final Handy/Blues Music Award ballot is ineligible. (All other musicians who have had peripheral and/or professional contact through performance with a Handy/Blues Music Award nominee, including but not limited to touring band members and studio musicians,

- are deemed eligible for the IBC. The exception is band members of a band nominated for the Band of the Year.)
- An individual may not compete in more than one act in any capacity and may not compete in both the Band Division and the Solo/Duo Division.
- A band is any act with three or more musicians. A Solo/Duo act is any act with no more than two musicians. Both electric and acoustic instruments are allowed in either category, and vocalists are counted as musicians for the purpose of this competition. A Youth Act is any act in which all performing members are under the age of 21 at the time of the IBC.
- ▲ No other entry restrictions apply. This means that management contracts, booking agent contracts, recording contracts, performance contracts (even those that include regular television or radio broadcast) and nationally distributed recordings have no bearing on eligibility.


